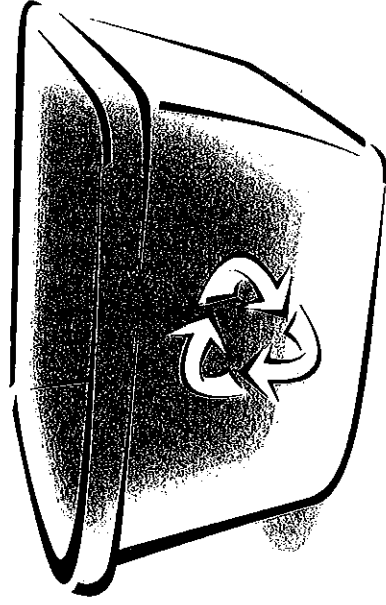
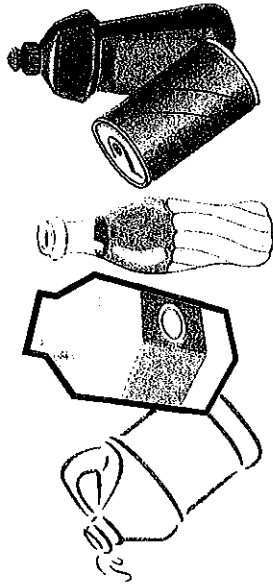


Faraday Blue Box Recycling

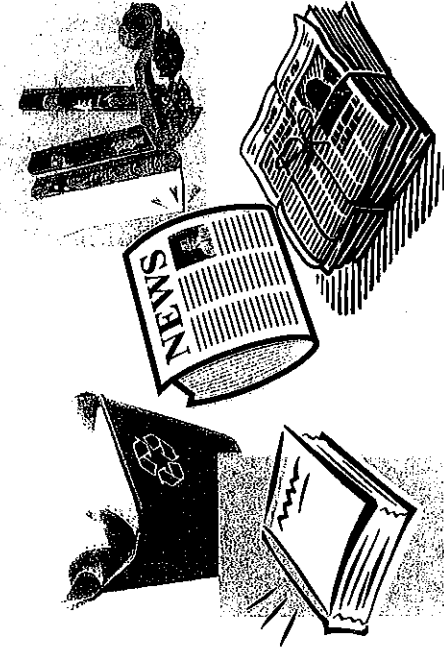
What Can I Put in my Co-mingle Blue Box?

- ✓ **Aluminum** foil, pop cans, pie plates
- ✓ **Steel** food & beverage cans and tins (soup, juice, etc.) empty aerosol cans
- ✓ **Glass** bottles & jars, clear & coloured
- ✓ **Plastic** jars & bottles, containers with symbol, H.D.P.E. & P.E.T.
- ✓ **Polycoat** drink boxes, paper coffee cups, milk & juice cartons
- ✓ **Plastic Bags (film plastic)** grocery, retail, dry cleaning, bread, rinsed milk pouches—**please put all bags into ONE plastic bag**



What Can I Put in my Fibre Blue Box?

- ✓ **Paper** writing paper, envelopes, books (please remove hard covers), non-metallic wrapping paper
- ✓ **Newsprint** newspapers, flyers, phone books, magazines, catalogues



What Can I Put Out with my Cardboard Recycling?

- ✓ **Cardboard** flattened boxes, pizza boxes, egg cartons, brown paper bags
- ✓ **Boxboard** cereal boxes (liners removed), paper towel rolls, boxboard tubes

All cardboard must be flattened and bundled beside your blue boxes

Some Common Blue Box Mistakes

- Some items end up in the Blue Box that shouldn't. Here is a list of items that are commonly mistaken as recycling:
- × Broken glass
 - × Drinking glasses
 - × Pyrex
 - × Light bulbs
 - × Window glass
 - × Ceramics
 - × Containers from hazardous or petroleum products such as motor oil

Why were some/all of my items not collected?

- This material is not recyclable
- Glass, metal & plastic must be loose in Blue Box
- This Blue Box is not compatible with our collection vehicle The lip around the top hooks onto the truck for easy sorting and the bright blue colour makes it highly visible for our drivers. Please contact your township office to obtain additional Blue Boxes.
- Film Plastic must be bagged and tied
- Contain newspapers, magazines, etc. paper material should be in an unried plastic bag or neatly stacked in your box to prevent blowing
- Please change Blue Box location to make collection more efficient we ask that you place your Blue Box (es) where we left them today. Your cooperation is appreciated
- Your Blue Box needs cleaning A soiled Blue Box may attract pests & contaminate recyclables
- Containers must be rinsed
